The Garland Thayer Award

Garland Thayer was People Incorporated's founding Executive Director. Initially hired as an elementary school principal in the small Washington County community of Hayter's Gap, Mr. Thayer's vision, leadership and dedication to the community led to the agency's founding and the beginning of many of the programs, services, and philosophies that characterize People Incorporated still today. The Garland Thayer Award is awarded to an individual who, in the course of their employment or paid position with an organization, has made a significant contribution to benefit low-income people. Past award recipients have started new organizations, new programs, or new services that are in keeping with People Incorporated's mission of providing opportunities for people to improve their lives, their families and their communities.

The Henderson Award

Mr. Thayer's efforts to revitalize and rejuvenate the community would not have been possible but for the contributions and support of Fount and Thelma Henderson. Mr. Henderson, who was People Incorporated's founding Board of Directors Chairperson, and his wife Thelma were active community volunteers who worked tirelessly with Mr. Thayer to mobilize the community in support of the agency's mission to make Hayter's Gap a better place to live. The Henderson Award recognizes a remarkable volunteer or a group of volunteers who have made lasting and significant contributions to benefit low-income people through their unpaid work.
